Glenn was a hard worker, who gave 35 years of his career to the Potash Corporation in Lanigan. He loved doing home improvements under the auspicious eye of Vivian, and was a proud gardener, growing perfect vegetables and beautiful sunflowers year after year. He was noted as a great neighbor, helping anyone who needed their driveways shoveled or help around the yard. Glenn gave his golf opponents a good challenge with his left-handed drive and was an avid fan of the Roughriders whether winning or not. Winter months saw him ice fishing at Stony Lake in the early morning hours, long after his famous career of "Slo Mo" hockey had ended. And when coming home after any outing, loud music could be heard two blocks away, blasting from his truck. Glenn was happiest when surrounded by family in Humboldt or Leroy, Calgary or Edmonton, whether it was Christmas, a summer BBQ, or simple long weekends. Nertz and 'Pass the Ace' competitions became fierce, with laughter always rounding out the night. In recent years, Viv and Glenn enjoyed trips to Hawaii and Mexico, and in November 2014, made a memorable trip to Norway to visit Glenn's relatives.

To mourn his loss are his wife of 30 years, Vivian, and daughters Jenna (Jordan Hurlburt) and Tia (Charles Struck) – who were all the "apple" of Glenn's eyes. He also leaves his siblings, Lyonel, Connie (Mike Johb), Keith (Gerianne) and Wayne (Kathy), numerous nephews and nieces, uncles and aunts, as well as Vivian's sisters, Christine (Erwin Greisinger), and Debbie (Bob Picken).
