After completing Grade 8, Helene stayed home to help on the farm. She also worked at the Jansen Hotel for her aunt and uncle, Ada and Sam Wright for a few years. It was at a dance in Jansen that Helene met Erwin Hein. They dated for a few years and, on November 30, 1946, they were married in Saskatoon. Helene and Erwin resided on the homestead a mile south of Jansen and farmed there for three years. For a short time, they also lived in Borden, SK. In 1953, the couple moved to Lanigan where Helene worked as a cashier at Shop-Rite. Although Helene and Erwin didn't have any children of their own, they enjoyed their nieces and nephews and took a keen interest in who they were and what they did. They both shared a passion for music and for traveling and visited many points throughout Canada, the United States – including Hawaii, New Zealand, Australia, and England. An extremely talented and creative lady, Helene spent many fulfilling hours on innumerable sewing, crafting, painting and needlework projects which are beautiful pieces of art.
