His family meant everything to him and he'd always keep in touch. He made every effort to be home for most of the holidays, especially Christmas, where he would always over gift people with very thoughtful presents. It was sad to see him suffer with Lyme disease over the past five to six years. Dave tried so hard to educate himself about the disease, but found very little help or support. He treated himself with natural foods and a very strict diet. Sadly though, each year the disease took a greater toll on his body. Lately, even the simplest tasks became such an effort and he became so frustrated with being sick. Dave will definitely be missed by his parents, family and friends. He was a great guy!
