Otto was born on September 30, 1913, to Fred and Mary (nee Sukut) Schroeder at Jansen. He was raised on the family farm in the R.M. of Prairie Rose and attended school in Jansen. Following his education, Otto was employed by various farmers in the area. During that time, he met Johanna Briske and, on December 2, 1939, they were married. Their union was blessed with seven children, six sons and one daughter. During the first year of their marriage, Otto and Johanna lived and farmed at Borden, SK, then returned to help Johanna's father's farm in the Prairie Rose district. In 1948, they purchased land in the LeRoy district where they lived and farmed until retiring into LeRoy in 1981. Over the years, Otto enjoyed hunting, curling (even into his 90s), bowling, playing shuffleboard and cards, but his favorite pastime was driving the tractor and combine as recent as the fall of 2014. As well, he and Johanna loved traveling and made trips to China, Italy, Germany, Israel, Brazil, Hawaii, Alaska, and various points in eastern Canada. A humble man, Otto's quiet, gentle, and unassuming manner endeared him to all. He especially enjoyed visits from family and friends, who will always remember his wonderful smile and genuine bear hugs. Otto was well-respected for the high regard he had for his faith and his family. After suffering a stroke, Johanna became a resident of Quill Plains Centennial Lodge in Watson. On June 2, 2012, Otto's beloved wife of over 72 years went on to glory and, once again, Otto had to adjust to a new season in his life. He continued to live in their home until the present.
