But as God calls us one by one the chain will link again*

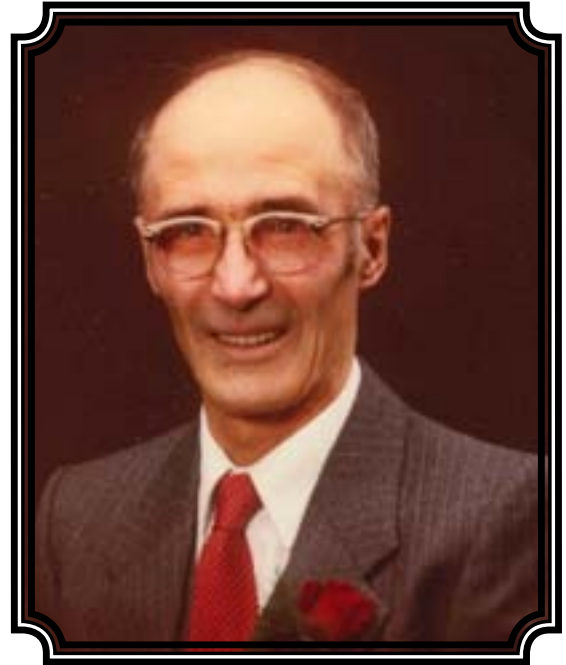
