Of your heart.

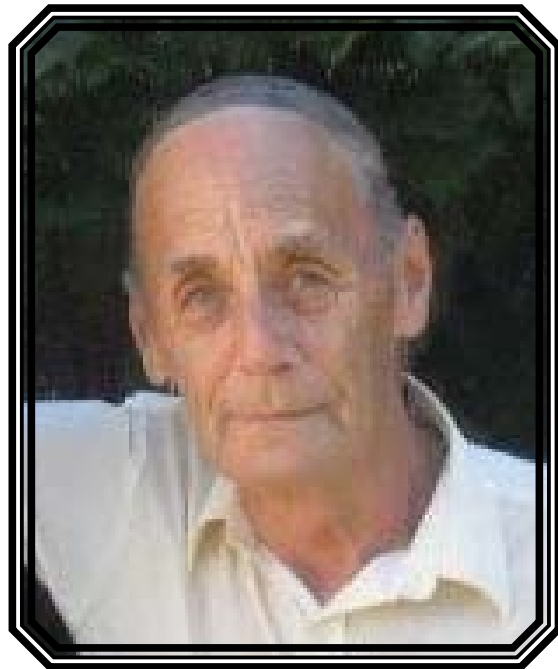
