

Harvey commented multiple times that he was only as successful as he was because of his wife. He was a big dreamer and Linda made those dreams happen by handling the details. Family meant everything to Harvey and he made every attempt to attend family functions, whether they be gatherings of the extended family, Christmas, Easter and Thanksgiving family gatherings or a grandchild's dance recital. In the two weeks before his passing Harvey taught his grandson how to drive an ATV and got out on the boat with his grandchildren reminiscing. In the days prior to entering hospice, Harvey was surrounded by extended family telling stories and sharing memories. Harvey also graciously gave his time in public service, actively volunteering with the Humboldt Jaycees and serving as chairman of St. Elizabeth's Hospital Foundation and as an alderman in Humboldt. He will truly be missed by all who knew him.

As I would do.**


