But now it's time I traveled on alone!*

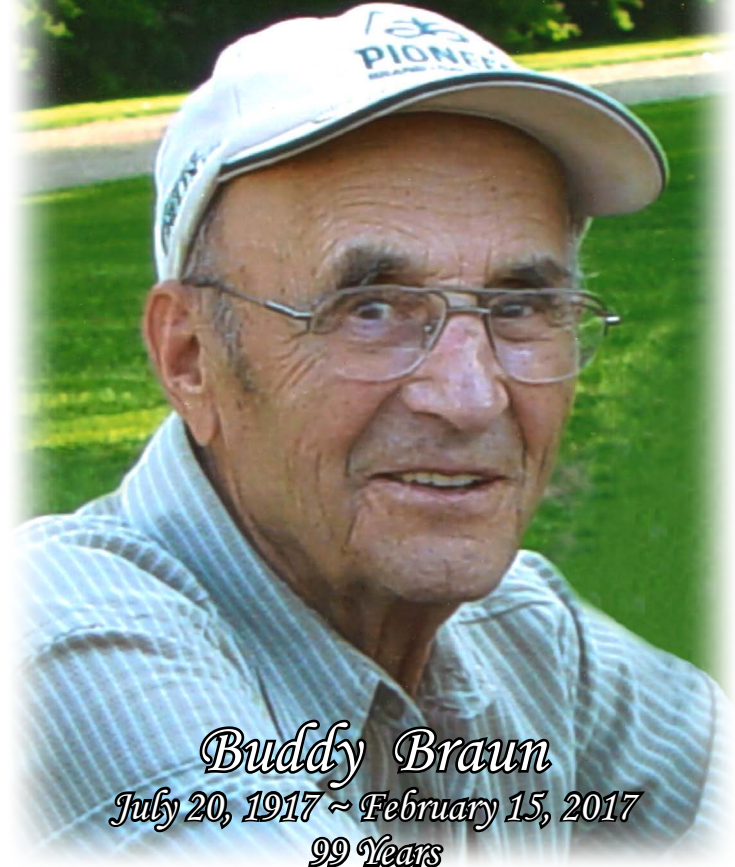
