That at harvest must come home."

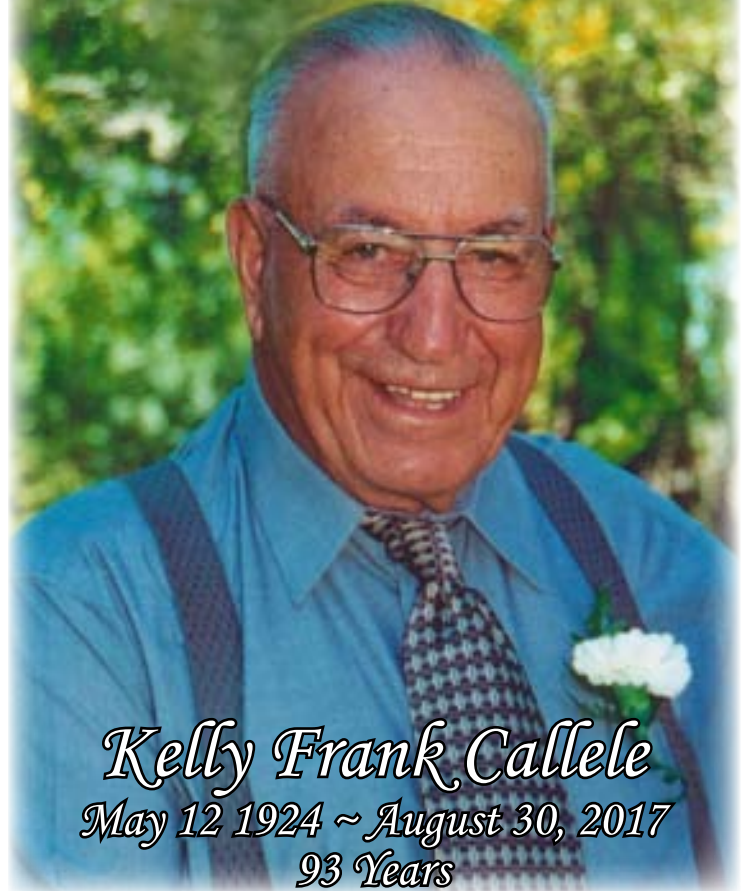
