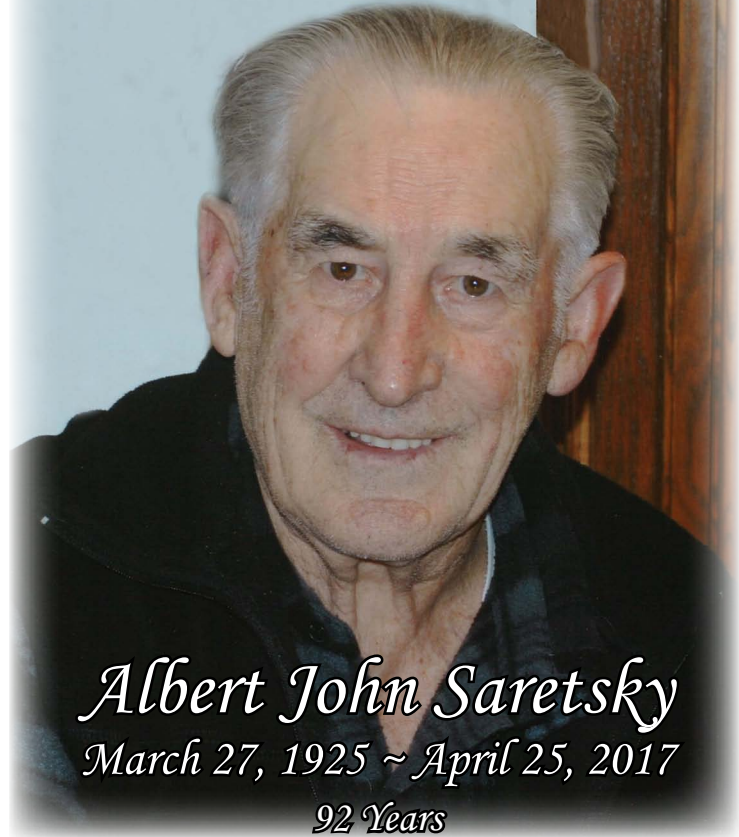

Albert attended St. Scholastica Church until 1984, and was a member of the parish choirs for a total of over 80 years, both at St.

Scholastica and later at St. Augustine when he moved into Humboldt. Albert married Catherine Thomas on June 16, 1973, and gained three stepchildren. Catherine passed away March 19, 1994. On June 8, 1996 Albert gained five more stepchildren when he married Beatrice Doyscher. Albert enjoyed farming, gardening, feeding the birds, playing cards and visiting.
