footprints, is when I carried you."

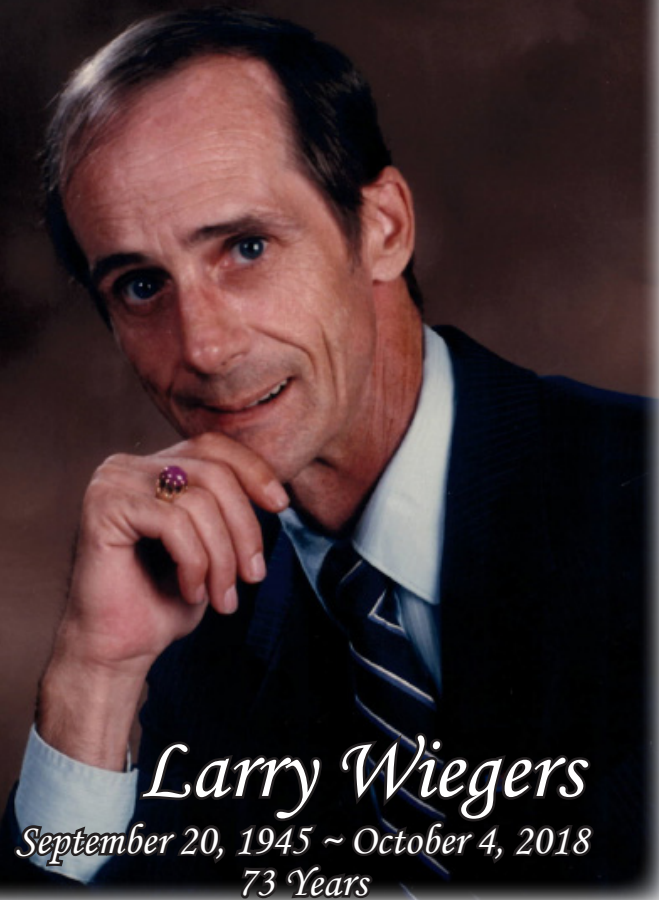
