It was around that time that she met her future husband, Emilien Moisan, whom she married on October 11, 1949. They were married for 63 years until Emilien's passing in 2012. Imelda and Emilien lived on their farm near St. Front until 1959, when they moved into the hamlet of St. Front, SK. In 1990, they retired and continued to reside in their St. Front home until 1995, when they moved to Watson, SK. In 2010, Imelda and Emilien moved to Humboldt, where Imelda continued to reside until her passing. Imelda was involved with the Ladies of St. Anne and the senior's club in St. Front, and was active with the CWL in Humboldt. In her leisure time, she loved quilting, sewing, crocheting, fishing, and playing cards. Imelda was her happiest when she was cooking and entertaining for family and friends. She was a patient, kind, and saintly woman, living life "one day at a time".
