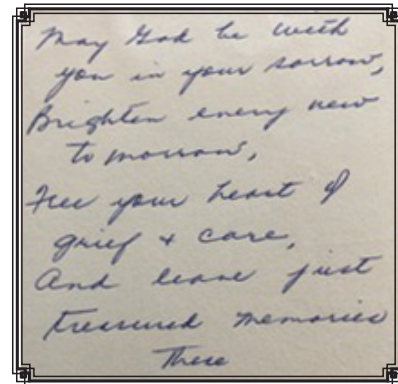

Chris left home at 16 years of age to go to Brandon College for her Grade 12, followed by her BA (Class of '33). She became a Psychiatric Nurse (Brandon Mental Hospital, Class of '36), and a General Nurse (Jubilee Hospital in Victoria, BC, Class of '39). She returned to Brandon to work as a night supervisor and an operating room nurse at the Mental Hospital. It was in Brandon that Chris met Arnold Storey. They married in 1942, ten days before Arnold left for England to serve with the RCAF Medical Corps. Chris joined the British Nursing Reserve and worked in emergency hospitals in England as well. Her first of three daughters was born there at the end of the war. Once her girls were in school, Chris worked in a Saskatoon doctor's office until she retired in 1977. Her life was full, and her interests and skills were many. She maintained close ties to her large extended family and her many friends. Her Christian faith was unwavering, her counsel was wise, her strength of character and kindness were evident to all who knew her. Chris was thankful in all circumstances.
