Agnes (nee Cunningham) Koberinski; and by his brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law.

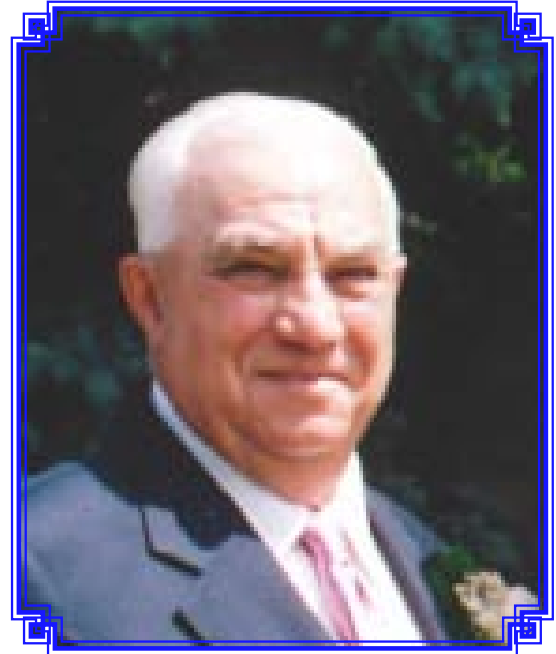
