Eugene was born on April 12, 1940, to Mandary and Ann (nee Rolick) Baduik at Quill Lake, SK. He grew up on the family farm in the Westasta area and attended Westasta Rural School until completing Grade 9. He then continued his education at Quill Lake School. After completing Grade 11, Eugene began working as a grain buyer for the National Grain Company in Spiritwood, SK, where he was employed until 1970. At that time, he took over the family farm near Quill Lake. In 1963, Eugene married Muriel Nivon in St. Front, SK. Five children, three daughters and two sons, were born to them. Tragically, in 1978, they lost their daughter Lena Ann in a car accident. As well as farming, Eugene worked for the Sask. Wheat Pool in 1979 and 1980. Three years later, he accepted a position with the R.M. of Spalding. Eugene and Muriel retired from farming in 1996, and moved into the town of Spalding. Eugene had a zest for life and pursued a number of hobbies and interests. He had always been very athletic and was proficient in high jumping, competing on the provincial level, and he even jumped over gates instead of opening them. In addition, he loved baseball, hockey, curling, boating, hunting, fishing, snowmobiling with his children and grandchildren, and driving the boat for the kids to waterski. Woodworking and spending time at his Marean Lake cabin filled many more pleasant hours.

Eugene will be lovingly remembered and sadly missed by his wife of 51 years, **Muriel** (nee Nivon) Baduik; 4 children and 8 grandchildren: **Lianna (Grant)** Franko and children **Tanner** and **Shyla** (Dustin Williams); **Debbie (Myron)** Nordick and children **Kale, Tegan** and **Shania**; **Cory (Charlene)** Baduik and children **Haley, Josh** and **Brett**; and **Todd** Baduik; 1 sister, Doreen (Jack) Lloyd; and by 2 nieces: Sherryl (Ray) Utigard, and Kim (Don Schiewe) La Chappelle, and their families.
