Together, she and George lived and worked side-by-side on the Bolster homestead in the Fulda area until 1986, when they retired from farming and moved into Humboldt. Florence began working at Thoms Fabrics, and then moved on to Sears where she was employed for the next 21 years, at which time she retired. Florence was also known as the first Tupperware lady in the area. Florence and George enjoyed a full and active social life. She absolutely loved it there; the staff was like an extended family and she also met and became friends with a lot of customers. Florence and George enjoyed a full and active social life. They both had a passion for music and dancing (including ballroom and square dancing), and attended dances in Humboldt, Saskatoon, and other places at every opportunity they could. When Florence entered the dance floor at the beginning of the evening, she seldom got off the floor until the band packed up. She also enjoyed the outdoors and camping, and loved to go walking, which she did almost every day, rain or shine. As well, Florence and George traveled extensively, going on cruises, and touring throughout Canada, the United States, and Europe. Many winters were spent in Junction, Arizona, which Florence continued to do right up until this year. George passed away on December 1, 1998. Florence continued to reside in Humboldt until she moved to Saskatoon, her home until the present.
