On October 29, 1945, Marie married the love of her life, Joseph "Joe" Duerr in St. Joseph's R.C. Church at Old Fulda. In 1947, they were blessed with the birth of their first child, Brenda, with further blessings to follow over the next few years with the births of Roger, Beryl and Kim. The Duerrs moved to Humboldt in 1973. Over the years, Marie spent innumerable pleasant hours sewing, baking, cooking and crocheting. After moving into Humboldt she also enjoyed bowling, golfing, going on casino trips, and traveling with Joe to various locations in the United States. They even went on a cruise to the Bahamas, which they loved. Of great importance to Marie was getting the family together for visits throughout the year and, particularly, on special holidays.
