Julius was born in the Jansen District on June 1, 1922 and attended Illinois school. He completed grade six and helped with the farming operation. When he was 18 years of age he enlisted in the Army but was rejected due to health reasons, so continued to help on the farm.

Julius met and fell in love with Luella Schulz and they were married on October 29, 1943. They lived in Regina for the first winter and then back to the farm the following spring. They were blessed with the birth of five children: Janet, Lois, Donald, Patsy and Becky. Julius served on various committees and boards: Lampard school trustee, Sask. Wheat Pool, LeRoy Co-op, LeRoy School and LeRose Lodge. He was 10 years with the LeRoy Town Council and also served as the town constable as well. For 12 years, he was served as a director and then as president of the LeRoy Credit Union. Julius was the president of the National Farmers Union Local #612 and the most challenging position he held was chairman of the C.N.D. Hatke Lake drainage project from its conception to its completion. In 1978, Julius organized the Full Gospel Businessmen's Fellowship International, Lanigan-Humboldt Chapter, and served as president for one year. In 1979, Julius retired from farming and started his own wholesale business named Jewel Enterprises Ltd. incorporated for importing and distributing "Organic Health Natural Products" Cosmetics and Vitamin Supplement Formulas to most health food stores in Saskatchewan.

Since 1981, they were involved in Living Word Outreach Ministries. In their retirement years, Julius and Luella enjoyed winters in the Clermont, Florida area. They enjoyed their summertimes fishing, boating, golfing, travelling, camping with family and playing board games—especially dominos, home and castle. But most important to Julius was the fact that he gave his life to the Lord Jesus Christ and served Him faithfully.

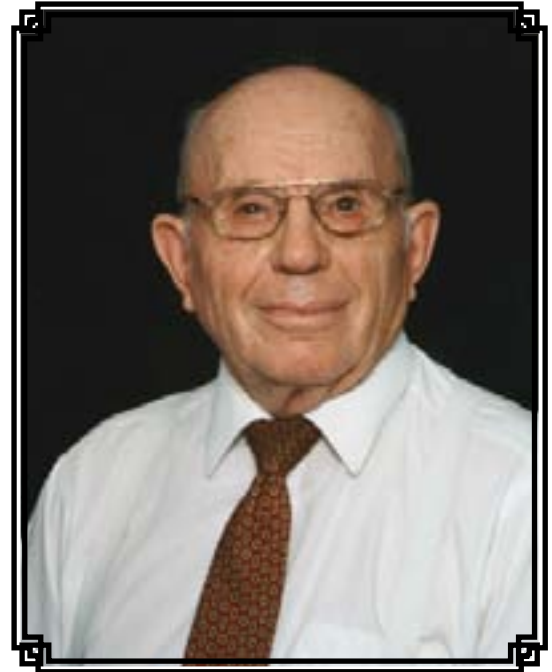
