Emil was born on November 10, 1935, to Jerome and Emilie (nee Gilliard) Florizone in Prud'homme, SK, and was raised on the family farm. He was the second of eight children and attended Buffer Lake School and Vonda School. After school he started farming and worked to achieve his heavy duty and industrial mechanic journeyman certificates. Emil married Janet Felix, October 10, 1955, and was blessed with six children: Ken, Don, Rita, Gary, Linda and Donna. He farmed near Prud'homme and also worked at the Colonsay mine for many years. Emil was involved with the community, and participated on various committees, including the Credit Union Board, federal politics, farm debt review, and the CAFF program.

Emil later married Annette Cales, June 2, 2001, and was blessed with three extended children: Dianne, Sandy and Jim. Emil continued to farm until 2008. He was passionate about farming and never found it hard to include others in his passion. If you wanted to spend time with Emil, you would find him working in the field or fixing machinery. Emil had a kind heart; he was a caregiver to many people, including his grandfather, his mother, and mother-in-law, and also provided advice and support to many family members, including brothers, sisters, nieces, nephews and children. He was comfortable to say what needed to be said in an effort to solve even the most difficult situations. Emil loved to cook and was thrilled to offer a barbeque dinner any day of the week. He could throw together an amazing soup in no time.

Emil enjoyed weekly discussions with his friends over coffee and always brought his witty and sharp mind to the table. Mazatlan was a frequent escape from the Saskatchewan winters. He developed a friendship with a Mexican family with whom he shared many special moments. A piece of land, better known as "The Hill", was a transition from farming to retirement; it later turned into another one of his favorite places that he whole-heartedly enjoyed. The Hill became the hosting grounds for numerous reunions and family gatherings. Emil will be lovingly remembered by his wife, Annette Cales; his six children: Ken Florizone, Don Florizone, Rita Schmid, Gary Florizone, Linda Surine, Donna Parker, 16 grandchildren, and two great grandchildren; three step children: Dianne Pilla, Sandy Hembroff and Jim Kopp; and six step grandchildren; seven brothers and sisters: Paul Florizone, Lionel Florizone, Louis Florizone, Annette Levesque, Anne Marie Sawka, Rose Marie Florizone, and Terry Lepage, and many in-laws. He was predeceased by his parents Jerome and Emilie Florizone.



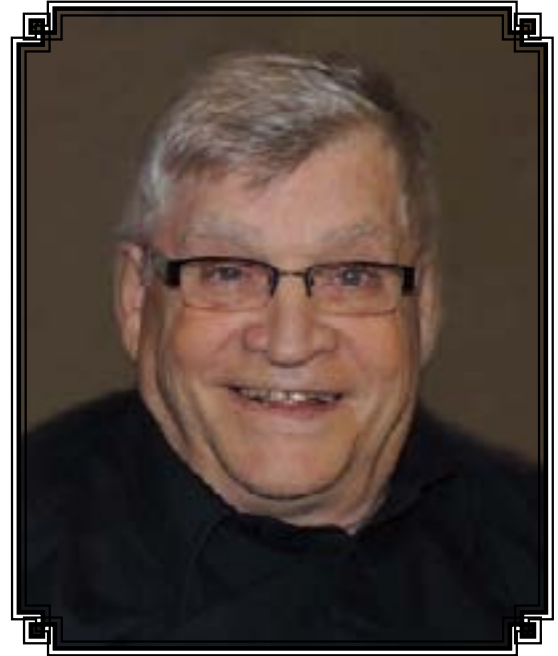
