Leo also enjoyed puzzling and playing cards with his friends in town, or just sharing a good cup of coffee at the table with neighbors.

Leo will be lovingly remembered by his wife, Agnes of 51 years; daughter Bonny (Craig), Quinn and Shea of Saskatoon; son Brad (Leann), Colby, Carter, and Brody of Muenster. Leo is survived by one brother Tony Frerichs, and two sisters Annie (nee Frerichs) Strueby and Mary Frerichs. He always had somehow,*


*Take off your gloves and put them down, no more sweat
