Erwin was born on March 22, 1924, to Ferdinand and Nathalia (nee Rucks) Hein at home on the family farm near Jansen, SK. He grew up there and attended Bieberdorf School. He continued there until retiring in 1989, after a lifetime of hard work. Erwin and Helene thoroughly embraced their retirement years, enjoying day-to-day life and travelling extensively worldwide. Throughout the years, Erwin loved being outdoors and going fishing. As well, he was an avid gardener, and was very meticulous with planting, tending and harvesting the plot, an activity he indulged in as recent as last year. Music had also been a passion in Erwin's life; he was a talented banjo player and jammed with various bands at many seniors' homes and other places over the course of many years. Although Erwin didn't have any children of his own, he enjoyed his nieces and nephews and took a keen interest in who they were and what they did.

Erwin is survived by his wife Helene (nee Wright) Hein of Central Parkland Lodge, Lanigan; sister-in-law, Ruth Hein; brother-in-law, Gordon Lissel; sister-in-law, Elsie Webb; and by numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins.
