Denis joined the Oblate Brothers in St. Norbert, Winnipeg, MB, and served in northern communities for several years. In 1990, Denis moved to Guernsey and worked as a dairy hand at the Jerome Fisher farm for over 12 years, and then retired. On May 24, 2003, Denis married Eva Quilarto, the love of his life and the woman he adored.
