Evan was born at Port Phillip, Nova Scotia to John and Ada Kennedy (nee Angevine) on October 17, 1921. There he attended the Rockley School until 1929 when the family moved out west to the Morven district where he completed his school years. He worked on the family farm until 1939 when he went to the Lakehead (Thunder Bay, ON) to assemble "Hurricane" bombers for the war. He also worked in the lumber camps at Flanders, ON, before returning home to farm after the war. Evan was known in the district to have a good hand for welding. In 1945, he married Katherine Schlachter and together they raised three children on their farm at Morven. They lived there until moving to Humboldt in 1974 where he then worked as a handyman for a number of years. Their retirement years were busy with visiting family, dancing, playing cards, gardening and travelling. After Kay's passing in 2003, he became very skilled at cooking and keeping house as Kay did it. In 2010, Evan sold his home and moved into Kinsmen Court where he continued to have an active social life until his passing.
