Luc was born on July 23, 1948, at the Rose Valley Hospital, Rose Valley, SK, to Florian and Renée Montès. On January 30, 1970, Luc married Clémence Gaudet, and they were blessed with eight children: Augustin, Lynn, Rachel, Marc, Crystal, Daniel, Nicole and Matthew. They made their home in Guernsey, but their "cabin at the lake," where they often went to 'play', was their acreage in Plunkett, SK. During that time they started

their tradition of going for coffee at the Guernsey hotel to recuperate and make plans. Luc always provided for his family's needs. He always said God provided the mine job so he could provide for his family. He worked at PCS Lanigan for 37 years, first as an Industrial Mechanic, and more recently as a Hoistman. In his spare time, Luc loved to tinker and fix things. He had projects lined up for the next 300 years! If he didn't have the right tool for the job, he made it. Luc loved his family. On days off, his favorite thing to do was visit at his children's homes. Luc also enjoyed challenges. He could often be found doing crosswords, playing Sudoku, or playing minesweeper (until Crystal started beating his scores). Luc never hesitated

to help those that needed it, whether it was his children, a neighbor, or a complete stranger. His life touched many people's lives. He will be dearly missed.
