Dorothy was born on September 25, 1925, to Martin and Christina (nee Meschishnick) Plemel at home on the family farm in the St. Gregor district. She attended school in St. Gregor until grade 10 and from there she went to Ursuline Academy in Bruno. On July 5, 1948, Dorothy married Raymond Neuses in St Gregor Roman Catholic Church, St. Gregor. They made their home on the farm where they lived and farmed until 1965. At that time, they sold the farm and purchased a fishing lodge known as Little Bear Lake Cabins. They operated the cabins until selling the business in 1975 but continued to live there and took on the operation and maintenance of a 90-mile bush trap line. In 1984, Dorothy and Raymond retired to Watson, and thirteen years later, they relocated to Melfort. They enjoyed travelling and visited many destinations in Canada and the United States. Dorothy enjoyed doing beadwork, puzzles, gardening and casino trips. After Raymond's death in 2005, Dorothy moved into Humboldt where she resided until August 2013 when she moved to Quill Plains Centennial Lodge until her passing.
