Helen, the youngest of four children, grew up with a love for dancing, time with family and good food. She attended Lake Helen School and later Hyas School when they moved into town. In 1945, she moved to Watson with her parents where she worked as a clerk in the ladies department at Wolch's General Merchants. On August 1, 1950, she married Emil Prosko and their daughter Lynn was born in 1951. They farmed until 1968 and then continued to rent out the land. After Emil retired, they purchased a cabin at Fishing Lake where they spent many years enjoying time fishing and visiting with friends. After Emil passed away, Helen continued to live in Watson always willing to lend a helping hand. Throughout her years in Watson she supported numerous organizations including the Community Club, the Foresters, the United Church and the Legion Auxiliary. She was also very social enjoying weekly card games and time with friends. When her health deteriorated, she moved into long term care first in Watson and then in Saskatoon always looking forward to visits from family.

She is survived by her only daughter, **LYNN** Knafelc; three grandchildren, **Wyatt** (Heather) Knafelc, **Aaron** Knafelc and **Nancy** (Mike) Pavloff; and three great-grandchildren, Erik, Jack and Sarah Pavloff. Helen was predeceased by her loving husband Emil Prosko in 2000, her sisters Cassie Yaganiski and Nita Yaganiski, and her brother Mike Koroluk. Helen was the last of their generation in both the Prosko and Koroluk families.
