In good times, or in strife.*

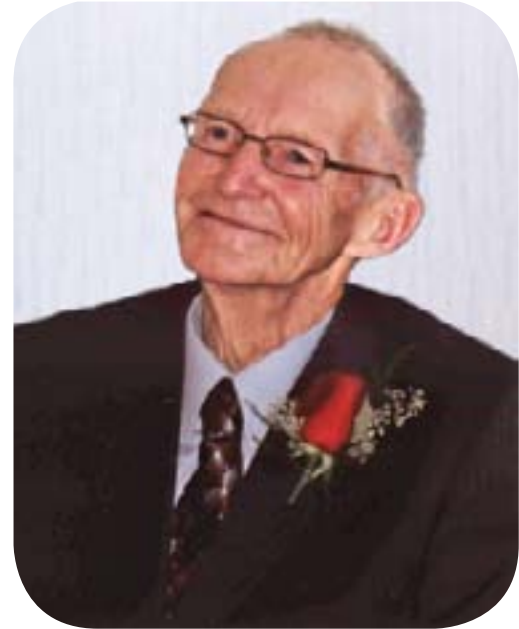
