While at St. Peter's College, he played with the Kampus Kings college band, was a member of the hockey team and showed his artistic side by being the artist for the yearbook. He continued his education at Saskatoon Business College which he put to good use on the Vidak farm. On July 16, 1966, he married Rosella Buhs. They made their home near the family farm where Martin, along with his brothers, ran a mixed-farm operation. Rosella passed away in 2007.

Martin's passions were music, flying, and reading. He also loved to go on fishing trips and travelling adventures. His love of music started by playing at various amateur talent shows and continued as the guitarist and singer with the Vidak Band for 35 years. He was a kind and thoughtful man with genuine concern for others, especially his nieces and nephews. Martin was so fortunate to have found a special friend in Paula Michel with whom he shared the last few years.

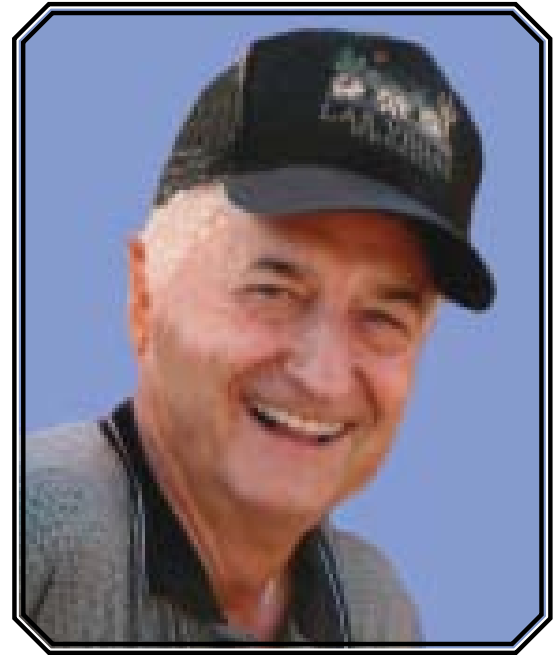
