Fay was born on May 9, 1925 in the Meacham/Peterson District to Joseph and Myrtle (nee Kelsey) Hogan. Her early schooling was in the Meacham/Peterson District but completed in Cudworth where she lived with her sister and brother-in-law, Genevieve and Leo Waldbillig. Fay married her "soul mate", Anton Wurm, on July 4, 1946.

Their life together was initially spent on his family farm outside of Peterson until flooding forced them to leave in 1955. They moved to Saskatoon where Anton worked for Domtar and Fay in the office of Pinders Drugs. Upon retiring, they returned to Peterson which they had maintained and farmed on weekends. Anton's passing in 1983 prompted Fay to move back to Saskatoon where she remained until 2011 when her health became an issue and she moved to the lodge in Watson. Being Irish by descent, mom's temper was quick to rise, but so much quicker to fade. Her wit and natural abilities for the blarney made her pleasant to be around and so hard to forget. She loved her family, friends, reading, writing, gardening, sunshine and laughter!



Fay will be greatly missed by her daughter, Judy Jones; granddaughter, Tracy (Mike) Roberts, and their children Mary Catherine and Michael of New Hampshire, USA; and many loving nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her husband, Anton Wurm, in 1983; and her daughter, Linda Wurm, in 2013.
